I bought a 17.2 hh mare three years ago who came with sores and scars on the inside of her thighs, her teats, along her mid-line belly and under her muzzle and her tail was awful. She has not actually got sweetitch but has a very itchy sensitive skin.

First I tried a **very expensive fly rug** but it was a huge effort to put it on and off on a daily basis and was so heavy and cumbersome for such a big horse.

I have followed an easy routine with Ruggles & Stopitall of shampooing her once a week with their special shampoo and oiling the vulnerable areas of underneath, tail, forelock and throat as and when needed and spraying her daily with the made up spray.

She is <u>entirely</u> free of rubbing and itching.

She can go out in the field without a rug although I avoid the really itchy times of day and she is happy and well. I recommend the regime wholeheartedly.
